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#### **Affected Products**

This hotfix applies to the shipping version of Autodesk AutoCAD 2014, and AutoCAD 2014-based vertical products.

# Issues Resolved by This Update

This hot fix addresses an issue with the file open command failing when a drawing is opened that contains custom entities with embedded 3D solids.

#### **Installation Instructions**

You must have administrative privileges on your Microsoft® Windows® operating system to complete the installation process.

This installation requires you to replace the following file:

acdb19.dll

# • To Replace the File

- 1. Close all software applications.
- 2. Navigate to your product installation folder; for example *C:\Program Files\Autodesk\AutoCAD 2014*.
- 3. In the product installation folder, right-click on the file below, select Properties, and go to the Details tab. Verify that the file has the following versions:

• acdb19.dll: 19.1.18.0

If the file version is different, the hotfix is already installed.

- 4. In the product installation folder, right-click on the file to rename it to acdb19.bak.
- 5. Download the hot fix for your application to a location on your local computer:
  - For 32-bit operating systems:
    Autodesk\_AutoCAD\_2014\_Custom\_Entity\_Hotfix\_32bit.zip
  - For 64-bit operating systems:
    Autodesk\_AutoCAD\_2014\_Custom\_Entity\_Hotfix\_64bit.zip
- 6. To install the fix, double-click the ZIP file and extract the file to the product installation folder.
- 7. To make sure that you have replaced the file correctly, right-click on the replaced file, select Properties, and go to the Details tab. You should see the following file version:

• acdb19.dll: 19.1.18.1

# **To Uninstall This Hotfix**

- 1. In the product installation folder, delete the file that you downloaded.
- 2. Restore the file you renamed to the original name (acdb19.bak to acdb19.dll).

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
