#### **Affected Products**

This hotfix applies to the Service Pack 1 or 1.1 levels of AutoCAD 2013 and AutoCAD 2013-based vertical products.

## Issues Resolved by This Update

This hot fix addresses an issue with the MASSPROP command returning an error or invalid results on certain solids created by extruding regions along closed polylines.

### **Installation Instructions**

You must have administrative privileges on your Microsoft® Windows® operating system to complete the installation process.

You must install service pack 1 (or 1.1 for AutoCAD) prior to applying this hotfix.

This installation requires you to replace the following file:

modlr19.dll

#### To Replace the File

- 1. Close all software applications.
- 2. Navigate to your product installation folder; for example *C:\Program Files\Autodesk\AutoCAD 2013*.
- 3. In the product installation folder, right-click on the affected file and verify that it has the following file version:

modlr19.dll: 19.0.114.0

If the file version is different, you either need to install Service Pack 1 (or 1.1) before applying this hotfix, or the hotfix is already installed.

- 4. In the product installation folder, right-click on *modlr19.dll* to rename it to *modlr19.bak*.
- 5. Download the hotfix for your application to a location on your local computer:
  - For 32-bit operating systems:
    ACAD2013SP1.1\_MASSPROP\_hotfix\_32bit.zip
  - For 64-bit operating systems:
    ACAD2013SP1.1\_MASSPROP\_hotfix\_64bit.zip
- 6. To install the fix, double-click the ZIP file and save the file to the product installation folder.

**Note:** Do not replace *modlr19.dll* present in the *C:\Program Files\Common Files\Autodesk Shared\AcDwgFilter* folder.

- 7. To make sure that you have replaced the file correctly, right-click on the file, select Properties, and go to the Details tab. You should see the following file version:
  - modlr19.dll: 19.0.114.4

## **To Uninstall This Hotfix**

- 1. In the product installation folder, delete the file that you downloaded.
- 2. Restore the file you renamed to the original name (e.g. modlr19.bak to modlr19.dll).
