To qualify for the Professional exam, Autodesk® Moldflow® Insight users must have already achieved Associate certification. The Professional exam is based on the classes Autodesk® Moldflow® Insight Productivity and Autodesk® Moldflow® Insight Performance. The questions on the exam are based primarily on the theory and concepts section of the training material. Topics are related to filling, packing, cooling, warpage, and include:

- Anchor plane setup
- Cooling analyses & results
- DOE
- Filling analyses
- Gate location options
- Modeling
- Molding Window
- Packing Analyses
- Results: Cooling, Flow, Warpage

The Professional exam not only covers the theoretical background of injection molding and the software, but how Autodesk Moldflow Insight is applied and interpreted to solve design and molding problems. In addition to a thorough review of the material in the training class, you should have completed several projects before taking the exam.

The exam consists of two sections. The first section has 110 multiple choice questions on the topics described above. The second section has 82 multiple choice questions based on modeling feed and cooling systems, determining the best way to set up parts to interpret the warpage, and results interpretation.

Passing the exam requires a score of 80% or greater. Feedback is provided after the exam so the areas that need improvement can be studied. Achieving this Professional certification makes you eligible for taking the Expert exam.
