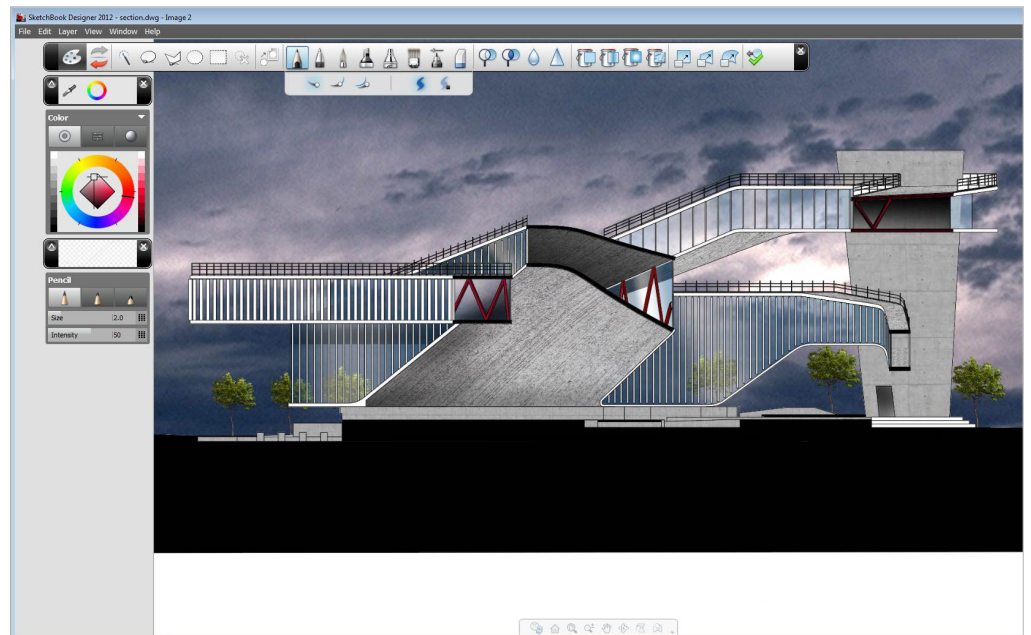

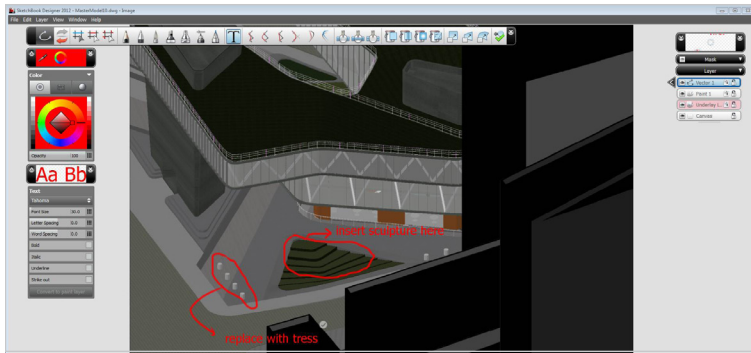

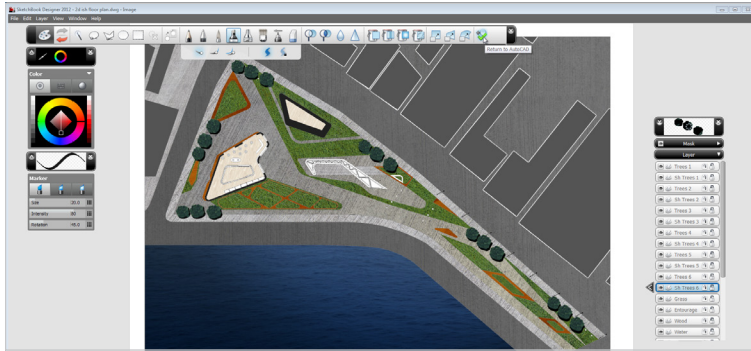

Sketch, mark up, and annotate directly on top of AutoCAD content. It's an easier way to share your feedback with your colleagues, providers, or customers.



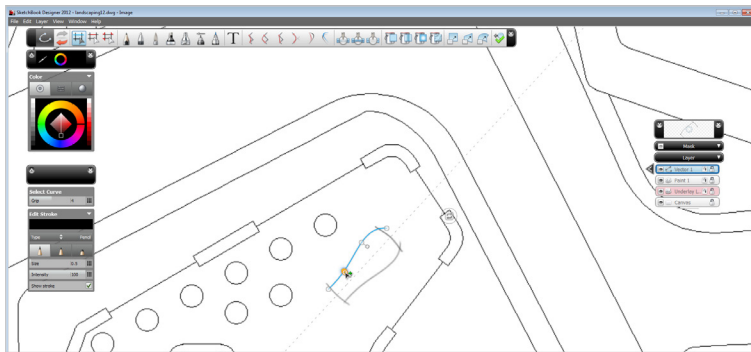

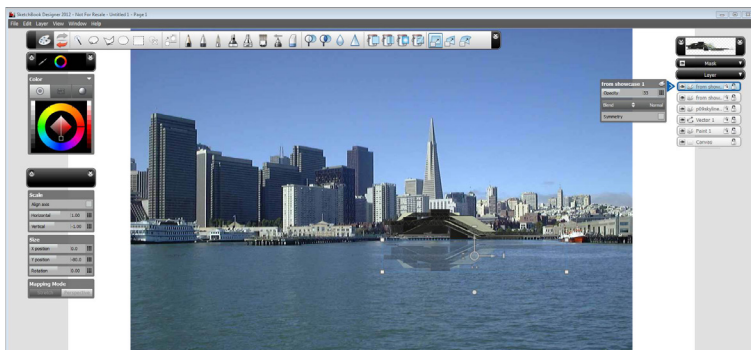
Sketch Concepts
