## 1. Autodesk® Toxik™ 2010 Hotfix 1

---

The following issue is fixed with Toxik 2010 Hotfix 1.

- Playback speed drops comes to a halt on Mac OS X 10.5.x MacPro 4,1 machines (bug #342368).

## 2. Supported Platforms

---

- Toxik 2010 Hotfix 1 is available as a 32 bit application on the following Mac OS operating system:

Mac OS X (10.5.5 or higher)

As bug #342368 is only applicable to the Mac OS X version of Toxik 2010, Mac OS X is the only platform on which Toxik 2010 Hotfix 1 is available. It is not available on Windows or Linux, as it is not relevant on those platforms.

## 3. Installing Toxik 2010 Hotfix 1

---

Toxik 2010 Hotfix 1 is NOT installed through the Maya 2010 installation. However, **it requires Maya 2010 to be installed for licensing to work**. Toxik 2010 Hotfix 1 **cannot** be run concurrently with Toxik 2010.

Installation on OS X:

1. Move the old installation to the Trash by trashing the installation directory, for example:  
/Applications/Autodesk/Toxik 2010
2. Double click on the new installation package file to proceed with the installation.

## 4. Licensing Toxik 2010 Hotfix 1

---

Toxik 2010 Hotfix 1 uses Maya licensing: the Toxik interactive application will request a Maya license. Please refer to Maya installation and licensing documentation for more information.

## 5. Questions and Answers about Toxik 2010 Hotfix 1

---

### **Should I install Toxik 2010 Hotfix 1 if I do not have any MacPro 4,1 machines?**

Toxik 2010 Hotfix 1 has been tested on a range of MacPro machines. It does not change Toxik 2010 behavior on machines other than MacPro 4,1. Therefore, in an environment with different MacPro machine types, it can safely be deployed.

The problem fixed by Toxik 2010 Hotfix 1 is related to hyperthreading support in the MacPro 4,1 CPUs. Therefore, Toxik 2010 running on any future Mac hardware with hyperthreading-enabled CPUs will also suffer from this problem. Autodesk therefore recommends moving to Toxik 2010 Hotfix 1 whenever convenient, to enable any future Mac hardware upgrades you may be planning.

## **How do I know if I have Toxik 2010 Hotfix 1 or Toxik 2010 installed?**

Go to the Help menu, and click on About. The first line of the top text box fully describes the Toxik version.
