## Installation

1. Download the appropriate file for your system.
2. Unzip the package and run the backburner.exe.
3. Follow the installation prompts in the installer.

## Uninstall Instructions

### Windows XP

1. Open Start > Settings > Control Panel > Add Or Remove Programs dialog.
2. Turn on Show Updates at the top of the Add Or Remove Programs dialog.
3. Select Autodesk Backburner.
4. Click Remove.

### Windows Windows 7

1. Open Start > Control Panel > Programs and Features.
2. Click View Installed Updates.
3. Select Backburner.
4. Click Uninstall.
