- Content browser migration may fail when migrations are done multiple times.
- During the content migration if the temp files (_Migrated files) are opened by any other application, the migration will fail.

To resolve these issues, download and install this file.

Installation Instructions

NOTE: You must have **administrative privileges** on your Microsoft Windows operating system to complete the installation process.

- 1. On the computer where the product is installed, close all software applications.
- 2. Navigate to the installation folder and browse to "VerticalAdMigrator.dll".
- 3. Right click on the file and select Properties.
- 4. For Windows XP, click on the Version tab, and for Windows Vista and Windows 7 click on the Details tab.

- 5. Check that the file version is "7.0.50.0".
- 6. Rename "VerticalAdMigrator.dll" to "VerticalAdMigrator.dll.org".
- 7. Copy the hotfix that matches your operating system to a location on your local drive.
 - For 64 bit operation system with AutoCAD Architecture 2013 or AutoCAD MEP 2013 use "ACA_MEP_2013_Content_Browser_Migration_Hotfix_64bit.zip".
 - For 32 bit operation system with AutoCAD Architecture 2013 or AutoCAD MEP 2013 use "ACA_MEP_2013_Content_Browser_Migration_Hotfix_32bit.zip".
- 8. Extract "VerticalAdMigrator.dll" from the zip file to the install location.
- 9. Verify that the "VerticalAdMigrator.dll" file version is "7.0.50.3".
- 10. Start AutoCAD Architecture 2013 or AutoCAD MEP 2013 and verify that it is running.

NOTE: You can restore AutoCAD Architecture 2013 or AutoCAD MEP 2013 to the previous state by deleting "VerticalAdMigrator.dll" and renaming "VerticalAdMigrator.dll.org" back to "VerticalAdMigrator.dll".
