

## Install the MotionBuilder 2012 Help

By default the Help in MotionBuilder is Internet-based. If you do not have reliable Internet access, you can download the MotionBuilder Help from the Autodesk Web site and install it locally as follows.

1. Download and run the Help installer from <http://www.autodesk.com/motionbuilder-helpdownload-enu>.
2. Follow the instructions in the installation wizard.
  - If you have a 32-bit system, the MotionBuilder Help is installed in the following directory by default: C:\Program Files\Autodesk\Help\motionbuilder2012.
  - If you have a 64-bit system, the MotionBuilder Help is installed in the following directory by default: C:\Program Files (x86)\Autodesk\Help\motionbuilder2012.
3. Once installed, select **Settings > Preferences** in MotionBuilder, then expand the **Help** section in the **Preferences** window.
4. Do one of the following, depending on whether you installed the Help to the default location:
  - If you installed the Help to the default location, set **Help Location** to **Local Computer/Network**.
  - If you installed the Help to an alternative location, click **Browse** to locate the custom local or network location of the MotionBuilder help.  
You can also click **Reset**, which prompts MotionBuilder to automatically find the location you specified for the documentation.
5. Click Ok to close the **Preferences** window.
6. Click Ok when the **Configuration file update confirmation** dialog box appears on your screen.

The locally installed MotionBuilder Help is now available from the Help menu, F1, and context-sensitive Help buttons.
