## Affected Products

This hotfix applies to certain localized versions of the following product:

- Autodesk® Infrastructure Map Server 2012

## Issue Resolved by This Update

- If you run Quick Plot to generate a map, and the Preview Dialog displays the message *"The application resources required to generate the plot exceed the settings defined by the administrator"*, the Quick Plot hotfix will resolve this issue.

## Installation Instructions

### To install the Quick Plot Hotfix

Note: You may require **administrative privileges** on your Microsoft Windows operating **system** to apply this hotfix.

1. Backup the following files before installing this hotfix:

```
<AIMS 2012 Installed Folder>\ www\mapviewernet\quickplotgeneratepicture.aspx  
<AIMS 2012 Installed Folder>\ www\mapviewerphp\quickplotgeneratepicture.php  
<AIMS 2012 Installed Folder>\ www\mapviewerjava\quickplotgeneratepicture.jsp  
<AIMS 2012 Installed Folder>\ www\fusion\widgets\QuickPlot\GeneratePicture.php
```

Notes:

- <AIMS 2012 Installed Folder> is located at **C:\Program Files\Autodesk\Autodesk Infrastructure Web Server Extension 2012** in the English release.
  - Depending on your configuration, not all of the above files are present in your <AIMS 2012 Installed Folder>.
2. Download and extract the hotfix zip file, 1406806-ajax-fusion.zip, to a temporary location.
  3. Copy the **www** folder of the temporary location to your <AIMS 2012 Installed Folder> to overwrite the existing files.
