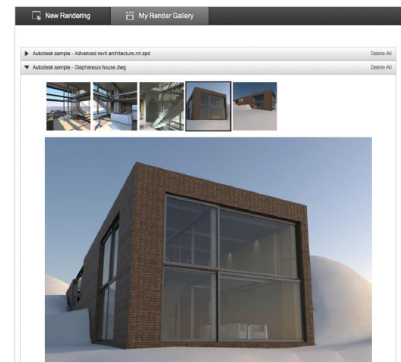
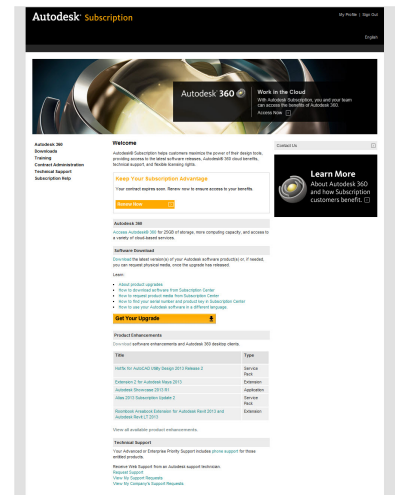
With Autodesk 360 Rendering, for example, you can create more photorealistic images and panoramas of your designs without spending countless hours tying up your desktop.
